

## Misión Peniel Needs – Post Hurricane Irma

### **NECESSITIES include:**

**FOOD** - nonperishable protein (peanut butter, tuna fish, sardines...), oatmeal, rice, beans, evaporated milk, powdered milk, pasta, sauce, tortillas, corn flour, fresh fruits and vegetables.

**CLOTHING** - please try to sort them by size before getting them to the mission:

**MENS** - S,M,L short sleeve shirts, t-shirt, pants 28-36" waist, tennis shoes, work boots, underwear, socks.

**CHILDRENS** - 2T - to – 12 years old, tennis shoes.

**WOMENS** - S,M,L (NO XL please) shirts, pants, skirts, tennis shoes, flat sandals (NO heels, please), socks, new underwear.

### **PERSONAL CARE:**

Disposable razors, feminine hygiene pads, deodorant, shampoo, diapers any size.

### **HOUSEHOLD:**

Basic kitchen supplies (pots, pans, wooden spoons, MANUAL can opener, mugs, plastic cups, silverware, plates, bowls, fans, grocery tote bags.

### **OTHER:**

BATH towels, sheets of any size, bed pillows, throw pillows, sleeping bags, mattresses, mosquito repellent.

As the Fall planting season approaches, the lunch sized coolers will be needed. Also, Irma will have disrupted the planting season, so many farmworkers may not have work, since the first seedlings to be planted have been damaged.

### **Dream – Wish List**

1. A walk-in freezer and generator – for weekly feeding program.
2. Material to build a community garden, so the farmworkers, who are so good at raising vegetable and fruits for others, can have a garden space of their own.
3. Sustainable, affordable, appropriate housing instead of the current housing rental properties which are dilapidated trailers. The landlords charge rent of \$60 per person per week.
4. Being able to purchase their own building.

As we receive more donations and supplies, volunteers are welcome who can come mid-week to help sort and organize. Please message us with your contact information if you'd like to come by yourself or with others at a time convenient to you.
